We would like to help Coordinate an Integrated Volunteer Program in Bandon, hoping to bring together all types of Organizations to help Bandon Residents deal with these & all difficult times. It would be a means to engage the Community through Commercially Sponsored Events, and Annual Fund Raising Activities, helping to Recognize and Encourage exemplary Bandon Citizens who make & shake our Community.

In order to help facilitate these objectives, Bandon's Harbertown Events Center will provide Non-Profits and other Community Organizations free meeting & activity space at BHEC Tuesdays from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm, when the Center will be open and available to encourage Community Involvement and Volunteerism.

We would have a Volunteer Notice Board & Non-Profit Information and Volunteer Sign-ups available at each event, trying to connect volunteering with community activity & spirit.

Bandon's Harbertown Events Center plans on doing some publicity to encourage the Community to come to the Center for Tuesday's activities, once those activities have been organized and implemented by Community members, and to use these activities as a way to advertise and distribute information related to the various Volunteer Opportunities in Bandon & on the South Coast.

We will also provide Non Profits the opportunity for one evening per month (excepting July and August) to put on fund-raisers or other large events. There would not be a rental fee charged, but there would be a returnable security deposit, a \$50 maintenance fee and proof of insurance required.

For both the Tuesday 10:00-4:00 meetings, and the Evening Events, we will provide a screen, projector, & sound system free of charge, when available, for those groups who arrange for it ahead of time. All groups would be expected to do their own set-up, take-down and cleaning, so that the room would be left in the condition it was found.

All groups should e-mail or call ahead of time to make meeting and activity reservations, so we do not have scheduling conflicts. There may be more than one group meeting at a time, if the groups are not too large.
